



## TWINNING

The City of Calvi in Umbria is twinned with the German town of Peiting and the French of La Bastide-des-Jourdans.

The German town of Peiting has 11,820 inhabitants and is located in Bavaria, in the administrative district of Upper Bavaria, along the Romantic Road. The twinning between the two towns was signed on 28/07/1989 by the mayors Gaetano Trandafilo and Klement Sesar in order to repair relations between the two populations that had opposed during the Second World War and to heal the wound open April 13 1944, when the hands of the German SS, were slaughtered 16 Calvesi. The twinning between the two municipalities, after many years, is well established and created real friendships between different families: twice a year, the exchange takes place in late July are the Calvesi to go to Peiting, while at the end August by Peiting arrive German families together which is organized Beer Festival, a real Oktober Fest, with all the typical Bavarian specialties, now famous throughout the province.

The commune of La Bastide-des-Jourdans has 1,381 inhabitants and is located in the Department of the Vaucluse region of Provence - Alpes - Cote d'Azur. 24/06/2006 The mayor of Calvi Silvano Lorenzoni and the mayor of La Bastide-des -Jourdans Michel Ruffinatti signed the act of twinning between the two municipalities. Again came a beautiful friendship between the families taking part in exchanges, which take place once a year, usually in July.
